- Aperol Spritz** £11.95
Aperol, an Italian aperitif made of bitter & sweet oranges and rhubarb poured over ice, a mini bottle of Bottega Prosecco with fresh orange slices and a splash of soda.
- Hot Ice Tea** £8.50
A Big Blue twist on the classic Long Island Ice Tea, Bacardi, Gin, Vodka, Tequila and Triple Sec layered over Pepsi.
- Cosmopolitan** £8.00
A cocktail made with Vodka, Triple Sec, Cranberry Juice and Lime Juice. This well known drink may be pink, but it still has quite a bite to it!
- Espresso Martini** £8.00
A sumptuous mix of Vodka, Kahlua coffee liqueur and espresso. Stylish, smooth and unexpectedly strong.
- Mai Tai** £8.50
A tropical cocktail mixing Rum, Lime, Orange Curaçao and Orgeat Syrup, with a sprig of mint and fresh fruit garnish.
- Negroni** £8.00
This bitter drink is the ultimate Italian aperitif. Gin, Sweet Vermouth and Campari stirred over ice. Simple yet tough to beat.
- Bacardi Superior Mojito** £8.50
A tall refreshing Cuban signature cocktail of Rum, Lime juice, Sugar and Mint churned over crushed ice and topped with soda splash Angostura bitters.
- Piña colada** £8.00
First made in Puerto Rico back in 1952, the Piña colada is a sweet and tasty cocktail made with Rum, cream of Coconut and Pineapple juice.
- Strawberry Daiquiri** £8.50
The Strawberry Daiquiri is sweet and refreshing, made with our homemade Strawberry blend and plenty of Rum.
- Caipiroska** £8.50
Zesty Lime juice, Brown Sugar, plus a pure, clean pour of Vodka - the Caipiroska is an adaptation of the classic Brazilian cocktail the Caipirinha.
